

Prof. Mauro Carraro graduated in Chemistry in 1998 and completed his PhD at the University of Padua (1999–2001). He subsequently held postdoctoral fellowships funded by the CNR and the University of Padua (2002–2003), and undertook short research stays at institutions including P. and M. Curie University (Paris), Jacobs University Bremen, Delft University of Technology, among others. He is currently Full Professor at the Department of Chemical Sciences, University of Padua, where he teaches Organic Chemistry and Green Chemistry. His research interests include: (i) Metal complexes and nanosystems for catalysis and nanomedicine (ii) Hybrid materials for catalysis and water treatment (iii) Circular economy approaches to industrial waste valorization. He is the author of around 110 publications, 5 book chapters, and 1 national patent.
