Dr. Marco Catillo graduated in Physics from the University of Rome La Sapienza in 2015 and in 2019 received his PhD in Theoretical Particle Physics from the University of Graz, Austria, where he worked on strong nuclear interactions, specifically on lattice quantum chromodynamics simulations. After a postdoc at the University of Munich (LMU) in Germany and subsequently at ETH Zurich in Switzerland, he began working as a researcher at ENEA by the end of 2023 under the project: National Centre for HPC, Big Data and Quantum Computing (ICSC), where he is currently working on numerical simulations for materials physics, with a focus on machine learning applications in material science. At ENEA, he has also been involved in other projects such as IEMAP and EOCOE III.
