He studied production engineering at the RWTH Aachen University, Germany. He was from 1994 to 1999 research associate at the Chair of Metrology and Quality Management of the Laboratory for Machine Tools and Production Engineering (WZL) of the RWTH Aachen University (www.wzl.rwth-aachen.de).

In 2000 he joined Carl ZEISS Industrial Metrology GmbH in Oberkochen, Germany (www.zeiss.com/imt). He held various management positions and is today Head of Technology & Modules in the Business Unit Multisensor-CMMs (Coordinate Measuring Machines) of ZEISS IQS (Industrial Quality Solutions). Dr Imkamp is member of ISO TC 213 "Dimensional and geometrical product specifications and verification" as German Delegate and member of different national standardization committees in Germany.

The European Commission appointed Dr Imkamp in 2019 as member of the EURAMET (European Association of National Metrology Institutes) Research Council.
