Gianandrea Salerno is Associate Professor of Entomology at the Department of Agricultural Science since 2018. He holds a Ph.D. in Agricultural Entomology (2001) and has been a Permanent Researcher since 2008. Author of 114 scientific papers (99 in ISI journals) and 2 book chapters, his research focuses on insect–plant mechanical and chemical interactions, behaviour and chemical ecology of parasitic Hymenoptera, agricultural pests, plant defences constitutive or induced by herbivore, insect morpho-functional adaptations, and insect electrophysiology
